May we listen with hearts open to receive the Good News as Mary MacKillop once did, finding comfort and courage in the wisdom of your Word. We ask this in your name.

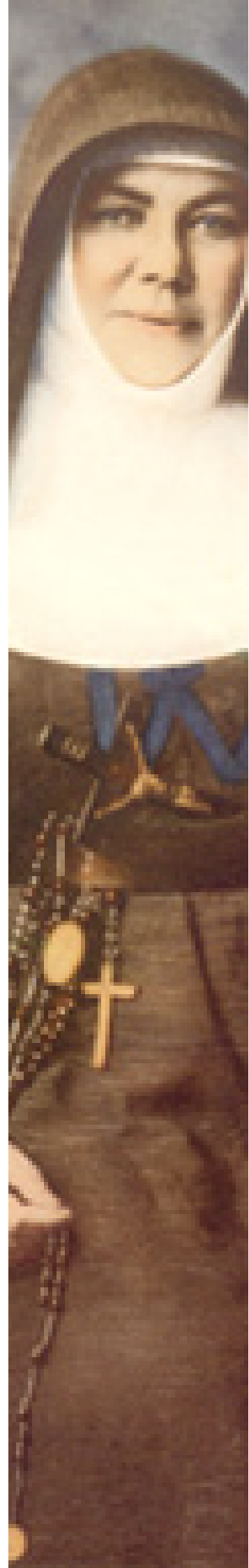
We are Travellers Here
