OUR STORY

The Associate movement stems from the teaching of the Second Vatican Council with its vision of Church as community.

The Congregational Chapter of the Sisters of St Joseph of the Sacred Heart in 1983 addressed the issue and stated: "The Superior General and Council will explore the possibilities of extending our concept of Josephite membership." In light of feedback from the Congregation a decision was made to explore the possibility of a Josephite Associate Movement.

Lay communities in Europe were visited and the simple motto and organization of the young San Egidio Movement in Rome attracted the Sisters' attention. Their motto was Friendship, Prayer and Service.

In September 1986 an expression of potential Josephite Associateship was published in the Congregational Newsletter. The hope was to enter into a spirit of communion between the Associates and the Sisters, with St Joseph as a model in his love and caring of Jesus and Mary.

Josephite Associates have a particular way of loving and living discipleship according to the Gospel.
