CHARISM

A charism is simply a gift or calling of the Spirit given to be shared with others for the building-up of the reign of God. It is a living passion for whatever dimension of the life of Christ is needed now, here, in our time. It can live in us only when we accept it. It can live only when it is continually nurtured, energised, renewed and developed in us. It can live in us only when we take responsibility to use it. 


