In my previous newsletter insert, I referred to National Catholic Safeguarding Standard 1, which is Child Safety is embedded into institutional leadership, governance and culture. We have continued working towards this Standard and ensuring that our Congregation publicly takes a zero approach to child abuse and that all within the Congregation are aware of their responsibility to contribute to a child safe environment.

Later in March, Sister Monica intends to release a YouTube clip in relation to Standard 1 so please look out for this and be sure to hear how Sister Monica will lead our Congregation in creating a Child Safe Organisation. More safeguarding updates shall follow Sr Monica's YouTube clip.
