

Philomena Catherine Hynes was born on 31 January 1946 the third daughter of Cecil Hynes a Diary Farmer and Elizabeth Parkinson. Her siblings were James (dec), John (dec), Ellena rsj, Bernadette rsj, Peter, Cecilia (dec), and Anne.

Philomena entered the Sisters of Saint Joseph of the Scared Heart at St Joseph's Convent South Perth on 2 February 1962, received the Habit on 6 January 1963 and professed as Sr Angela of the Good Shepherd on 7 January 1965.

Following her Profession Angela remained in New South Wales ministering in the Wollongong and Canberra Goulburn Dioceses.

In 1971 Angela returned to Western Australia and ministered in the Perth Archdiocese and Bunbury Diocese as a teacher and Parish Pastoral worker.

In 2017 Angela completed her ministry in Esperance and returned to Perth and Pastoral ministry in the Bentley area.

As her health declined Angela moved to South Perth 2019. It was here on 23 December 2021 that Angela passed peacefully away in her sleep.
