


JOSEPHITE COMPANIONS NEWSLETTER AUTUMN 2024

Sue D'Ath, embraces the lessons from the **Explore, Embrace, Embody** document of the Sisters of Saint Joseph of the Sacred Heart by recycling pre-loved T-shirts to create mats, making shopping bags from fabric offcuts purchased from secondhand stores and using tea towels or shopping bags instead of wrapping paper. Recycling, Reducing and Re-using are key actions to ensure that each one of us can look after the planet.

To make T-Shirt Mats

Step 1: Cut cloth into one continuous strip

Step 2: Roll into balls

Step 3: Crochet


