# Leonie's Josephite Journey

Kathleen Leonie Mayne known as Leonie was the second born daughter of Charles Thomas Mayne and Kathleen Mary Lindley. Leonie was born in Kalgoorlie Western Australia on 12 March 1937, the younger sister of Noreen RIP and big sister to Laurie and Teresa. Leonie lived her early years in the small mining town of Westonia nestled amongst 4,000ha of salmon gum, morrell and gimlet woodland interspersed with granite outcrops. It was here that Leonie developed her love of the Australian bush especially through the poetry of Banjo Patterson.

On completion of her secondary education Leonie entered the Sisters of Saint Joseph of the Sacred Heart at South Perth on 24 May 1953. She received the Habit on 5 January 1955 and was professed as Sr Gregory of the Holy Ghost on 5 January 1957.

Following her profession Sr Gregory returned to Western Australia and commenced her ministry as a Primary teacher in Busselton a coastal town south of Perth. In the following years as a Primary and Secondary teacher, Leonie covered the length and breadth of the Archdiocese of Perth and Diocese of Bunbury. In 1988 Leonie was a consultant with the Catholic Education Office in Perth before moving into Adult Education.

In 1990 Leonie was appointed Provincial of Victoria. On her return, she was appointed Regional Officer in the Catholic Education Office of Geraldton for four years. 2000 found Leonie at Mary MacKillop Place North Sydney as the Hospitality and Facilities Co-Ordinator, a position she held until the end of 2003.

Returning to Western Australia, Leonie was part of establishing the Rural Network based in Merredin and spreading throughout the wheatbelt region. At the end of 2017, Leonie returned to the metropolitan area and while maintaining in contact with the people of the wheatbelt began a ministry of Prayer and Hospitality, initially at Wilson and then at South Perth.

In 2022 Leonie moved into care at Margaret Hubery House Rossmoyne where she passed peacefully away on 21 January 2025.

Leonie, with your spirit of service in the footsteps of Mary MacKillop and as a grounded country woman, you have been an inspiration to us. We have enjoyed your companionship, your yarns and your sense of humour. Now we farewell you with many fond memories. Go in peace, dear Leonie.
