Ponder it.


Let it speak to your inner spirit.

to the Potter God.




Mary lived the mystery of life, pain, uncertainty, suffering, joy, all in radical dependence on the Potter God.

Mary was facing election again as leader of the congregation.




Despite having endured many difficult years

What stirs in your heart as you hold these words of Mary MacKillop?


